

Excerpts from the letter from Brad Wright, Drainage Inspection Programs, Snohomish County Public Works department that directs us to do work on the detention pond. Information and requirements are summarized here:

1. The timeframe to complete the maintenance is one year from the receipt of this notice. The notice was sent on August 22nd. We must contact Brad Wright them when we are finished so that they can evaluate the work. His phone number is 425-388-3464.

List of required maintenance:

- 1 Remove loose, dead sticks and other material from detention pond.
- 2 Clear sediment from pipe entering cell one of detention pond coming from East.
- 3 Clear 10 feet around on the upstream side of the above referenced pipe (under the willow).
- 4 Locate and clear path to swale and dispersion ditch west of pond. Clear swale of trees, blackberries etc. to the point that only grass remains in swale.
- 5 Clear 10 feet around pipe entering above mentioned swale.
- 6 While the goats are doing a great job of keeping the pond vegetation under control, it is important that the amount of fecal matter entering the storm-water system is kept to a minimum. To that end, the pile of hay and goat waste located under the feed trough needs to be removed down to bare earth. This needs to take place at least yearly.

Additional Recommended Maintenance Actions (not required):

1. Continue to maintain your drainage facility and visit county website for information.
