# • Reserve Spending:

Spent \$2800ish (Doug to get total) on the mower and \$65 on the weed-wacker. Tom built a weed dragon torch (value \$300). The total amount we have in the budget is \$8k. We are looking at water timers, garden carts, and wheelbarrows. Looking at buying two larger garden carts and 1 wheelbarrow. There are several smaller hand tools which we are looking at repairing or replacing. Need to research more. Water timers (30) will wear out...total cost is around \$400 for the more simple mechanicals (\$13.30 each if you buy 5 or more). Shovels will cost a total of \$100. The total overall will be just shy of \$5k. Doug has pictures of equipment and will prepare to share with everyone when the package is finalized – by next Biogaian Meeting.

## • Budget:

We have spent \$1800 for our Biogaian budget YTD...which is our budgeted amount for the year.

### Workshops:

We have our first check in-hand for \$95 for our cob workshop! We have a plan for the last 2 weekends for 2 workshops (22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>) for How To Care for Your Roses and Compost!

Compost workshop is coming up Saturday. Kim & Nick, Jean, Ngabuen, Dee's husband, Katie, Doug, Patricia, Brian, Karly, and Kevin will be coming for sure. Maybe's are Nancy Chase, Daniel Rhodes, Justin Chapman, Sadhana. Michael will be able to attend the last workshop. We have collected or will have all materials collected with exception to roofing materials we will want.

### • Resources:

On 35<sup>th</sup> Street to the North...a large area is being cleared and 80 yards of wood chips, brick and urbanite (concrete blocks) is available. There is an \$80 hr charge for delivery of the woodchips but it would last us through the end of next year to provide enough for the remainder of our garden/food-forests/etc
