- UW winter interns. Anita is working with UW students for the Fall and Winter quarters.
 Students will contribute 3 hours per week this quarter and 15 hours per week in the Winter quarter. The interns will focus on;

 - Plant propagation seeds, cuttings from Forest garden. Goal is to have a nursery of native Forest Garden plants to share with others.
 - o Soil Analysis comparison from different parts of the meadow
- Forest Tenders. David and crew, along with Journeys folks, cut up a tree which had been taken down earlier this year. It will be split and dried for firewood
- Keyhole. MD and Miranda have been working on a project in the keyhole to terrace along the West slope to the fence.
