Trees – laminated root rot, should we take down some trees that are looking damaged? Sylvan has a friend with a forestry degree. Part of the natural cycle of a forest is having dead & dying trees for habitat. Trees falling at night . . . Journeys? Gross negligence? Kevin Britt is a lawyer we have experience with. Liability Issue? Request #1 offer Journeys space that is safer if windy. Ask our insurance policy? Let's leave the trees, and caution Journeys about best place to sleep in high wind. Brian will discuss with Journeys base camp. Helen will look into the buying signs. We will talk again.

Replanting Trees – We could transplant some big leaf maples from Alpaca Place, sweet chestnuts (plant in fall)

Chipper – buy new chipper (it is a 10 hours power leaf shredder), or buy an old one that Nartano evaluates and picks? Cost savings maybe \$200..... is it worth the time to drive far away to check them out. Might take longer. If we don't find a good local used shredder that will save us \$200 (under \$489) w/in 20 miles, before the one we have dies then buy one new.
