 - espalier is not currently irrigated
 - is there a place further down in Crestmont to move the tree to?
 - Mary believes it could be the salal and spiraea that are causing the problem and to address those first and reassess after
- (Patricia) update on deck between the micro-shelters
 - West organizing a workday to build the deck between the two micro-shelters
 - Weekend of March 12,13
 - has material list and design
 - electricity up there at one point in the future?
 - Take styrofoam blocks to Shoreline transfer station for proper disposal (duck tape needs to be removed)
 - We need to a potential lead to help coordinate styrofoam disposal
